Email Safety - Phishing

We spend much of our days communicating via email. Like other online spaces, our inboxes are susceptible to having virus-carrying spam content, known as phishing, pop up from time to time. Phishing emails often LOOK like reputable emails, but they come from malicious sources and often include links that can compromise your devices. Here are a few quick tips to keep in mind to help you avoid engaging with phishing emails.

Don't Trust Display Names

Check the sender's email address before opening a message – the display name might be a fake.

Check for Typos

Spelling mistakes and poor grammar are typical in phishing emails. If something looks off, flag

Review the Signature

Check for contact information in the email footer. Legitimate senders always include them.

Beware of Threats

Fear-based phrases like "Your account has been suspended" are prevalent in phishing emails.

Check in with the Sender

Contact the sender a different way, such as a phone call, to verify they sent the message, and it is not someone posing as them.
